

The rc.db file contains all persistent data from run to run. This includes race and driver data setup. The database included in this database contains the sample races needed to run an entire EAHORC race night from beginning to end. It also includes dummy drivers so that you can run the event in demo mode and watch how it works.

This database file is compatible with Race Coordinator v1.2.1.0 and beyond. Attempting to run it with an older version of Race Coordinator will yield unpredictable results.

To use this database simply copy it into <install_dir>\data and rename it to rc.db. If you want to preserve your old database which contains the drivers, races, etc that you've setup on your own make sure to backup your <install_dir>\data\rc.db file before overwriting it.

Note, that to run the qualifying race setup within this database you must also download and install the EAHORC custom heats from this site. Simply unzip them into the "<install_dir>\data\custom heats" directory. To verify they're setup correctly, simply go to manage/race and select the EAHORC qualifier race. If you get errors saying it can't find them you either need to remove and re-add them or move them on disk to the proper location. This race will not run properly without them unless you change the heat rotation type.
